7 Referees The Association, who is Hosting, is responsible to provide the referees. Games ending in a tie will play 1 - 10 minute (3 on 3) sudden victory OT period. If still tied after this period, there is a Shootout (please see below). Please advise Referees of this OT and Shootout requirement.

8 Timekeepers The Association, who is Hosting, is responsible to provide the timekeepers. Games ending in a tie will play 1 -10 minute (3 on 3) sudden victory OT period. If still tied after this period, there is a Shootout (please see below). Please advise Timekeepers of this OT and Shootout requirement.

9 OT and Shootout requirement Playing in a game (Semi-Final, Final) where there must be a winner

In the event of a tie after regulation time, the format will be as follows. All games sudden victory. First goal wins. Teams will play one 10-minute sudden victory period. 3 on 3. If after overtime there is no winner, then a 5-player shootout will occur with teams alternating shots. (Players who are still serving an overtime or regulation time penalty cannot participate in the shootout) The Team scoring most goals after 5 shooters will be declared the winner. If still tied the shootout will continue in sets of one, till there is a winner. Teams must change the players for shootout until they have utilized all players on roster. If there is a difference in the number of players between teams, the team with more players has option to designate the same number of players as opposition before the shootout begins. PLEASE ADVISE GAME OFFICIALS (referees/timekeepers) OF THIS. PLEASE INSTRUCT THE HOME TEAM WHEN SETTING UP THE GAME ON THE IPAD TO SHOW 1 OT Period (10 minutes) PLUS SHOOTOUT.

10 Receiving a Penalty in Overtime or your penalty at the end of Regulation has not been fully served

Should your penalty at the end of Regulation not be fully served the opposing team will start the 3 on 3 period, 4 on 3. Once the penalty is served and at the next stoppage of play, a player from each team is removed. (3 on 3) Should a Team receive a penalty during the overtime period, the other team gets to add a player. (4 on 3) If they receive a 2nd penalty the other team can add another player. (to a maximum of 5 on 3) Once the penalized player returns to the ice, at the next stoppage, one player is removed from each team. Example: 4 on 3, player returns, 4 on 4, stoppage, player from each team is removed, returns to 3 on 3. 5 on 3, player returns, 5 on 4, stoppage, player from each team is removed, resumes, 4 on 3 etc.
