In the event of a tie after regulation time, the format will be as follows. All games sudden victory. First goal wins. Teams will play one 10 -minute sudden victory OT period. 5 on 5 . If after overtime there is no winner, then a 5-player shootout will occur. Both shooters will go at the same time. (Players who are still serving an overtime or regulation time penalty cannot participate in the shootout) The Team scoring most goals after 5 shooters will be declared the winner. If still tied the shootout will continue in sets of one, till there is a winner. Teams must change the players for shootout until they have utilized all players on roster. If there is a difference in the number of players between teams, the team with more players has option to designate the same number of players as opposition before the shootout begins. PLEASE ADVISE GAME OFFICIALS (referees/timekeepers) OF THIS. PLEASE INSTRUCT THE HOME TEAM WHEN SETTING UP THE GAME ON THE IPAD TO SHOW 1 OT Period (10 minutes) PLUS SHOOTOUT.

Receiving a Penalty in Overtime or your penalty at the end of Regulation has not been fully served
