SUBJECT: 2024-25 SEASONAL CALENDAR

The Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) has approved key dates and details regarding the Seasonal Calendar for the 2024-25 season. This model adheres to the key concepts and principles of the Canadian Player Pathways framework from Hockey Canada.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### **PLAYER EVALUATIONS**

Player Evaluations for Representative teams will again take place in the Spring as was implemented for the 2023-24 season.

Typically, Spring Player Evaluations begin the Monday following OHF Championships. 2024 OHF Championships are scheduled for the third weekend of April – **April 19-21, 2023** 

New for 2024-25 and in an effort to maximize available ice-time, Player Evaluations for Divisions that are not eligible for the 2024 OHF Championships will be begin on **Saturday, April 20**<sup>th</sup>.

Divisions that are eligible for OHF Championships will begin the Monday after OHF Championships, as past practice, on **Monday, April 22**<sup>nd</sup>.

#### **TOURNAMENTS**

Tournament participation for all Divisions and Categories permitted to start September 20, 2024.

### **REGULAR SEASON**

The regular season for all Divisions and Categories permitted to start September 30, 2024.

All teams must be engaged in meaningful competition until March 1, 2024 – No teams may be eliminated from competition before this date.
